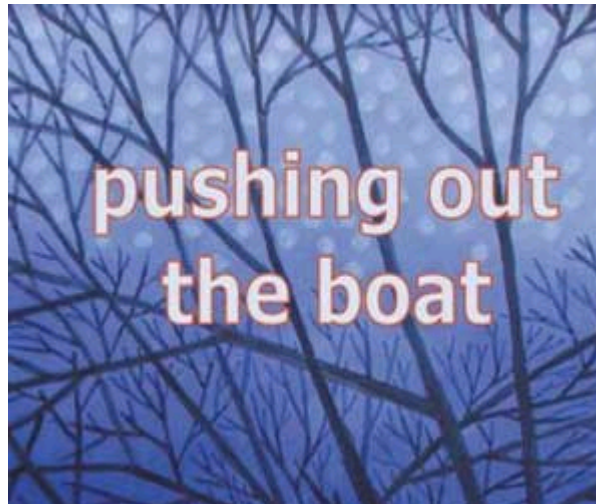


## Pushing Out The Boat - Issue 6
