APPLICANT/AGENT

An objection shall be intimated to the applicant:

- (a) by delivering to him a copy of the notice of objection lodged with the Licensing Board; or
- (b) by sending a copy of the said notice by registered post or by recorded delivery in a letter addressed to him at his proper address; or
- (c) by leaving a copy of the said notice for him at his proper address;

and, for the purposes of paragraphs (b) and (c) the proper address in the case of an applicant being an individual natural person shall be his place of abode as specified in his application and, in the case of an applicant other than an individual natural person, shall be the address specified in the application.

NOTES REFERRED TO

NOTE: In the case of an application for the grant of a new licence or for the provisional grant of a new licence this notice must be displayed at the premises in a place and at a height where it can conveniently be read by the public for a period of at least 21 days before the first day of the meeting of the Licensing Board at which the application is to be considered.

- (a) Name and address of applicant as specified in application to Licensing Board.
- (b) Name of Licensing Board.
- (c) Type of Licence.
- (d) Address of premises proposed to be licensed.
- (e) Date not later than seven days before the meeting of the Licensing Board at which the application is to be considered.
- (f) Address of Clerk to Licensing Board.
