 - (c) Seven plans of the canteen and particulars of the access to the canteen and of sanitary accommodation for persons using the canteen.
 - (d) Two character references in respect of the applicant (where an individual natural person) and in respect of the named employee or agent (where applicant is not an individual natural person).
