LEONARD'S, SANDYHILL ROAD, BANFF, AB45 1BH, A WRITTEN NOTICE OF OBJECTION SIGNED BY HIM OR HIS AGENT SPECIFYING THE GROUNDS OF HIS OBJECTION, AND MUST INTIMATE HIS OBJECTION BY THE ABOVE DATE TO THE APPLICANT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE UNDERNOTED PROCEDURE.<sup>5</sup>

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**PROCEDURES REFERRED TO:-**

Any objection shall be intimated to the applicant:-

- (a) By delivering to him a copy of the notice of objection lodged with the Licensing Board; or
- (b) By sending him a copy of the said notice by registered post or by recorded delivery in a letter addressed to him at his proper address; or
- (c) By leaving a copy of the said notice for him at his proper address;

And, for the purposes of paragraphs (b) and (c), the proper address in the case of an applicant being an individual natural person shall be his place of abode as specified in his application and, in the case of an applicant other than an individual natural person, shall be the address specified in the application.

<sup>4</sup> The date specified shall be seven clear days before the meeting of the Licensing Board at which the application is to be considered.  
<sup>5</sup> The applicant must, not later than three weeks before the meeting of the Licensing Board at which the application is to be considered, give notice in writing of the application to every occupier of premises situated in the same building as the premises to which the application relates.
