



- 1** The St Fergus Gas terminal is home to 4 major companies and nearly half of the UK's gas is pumped ashore here.
- 2** Scotstoun Head - The Admiralty trawler Struan ran aground in fog in January 1933. A rocket line was fired across the wreck but the nine trawlermen were rescued by the Peterhead lifeboat after five failed attempts to come alongside the wreck due to the sea conditions.
