Compulsory Registration for Private Landlords

As part of new national legislation all private landlords in Scotland will be required to register with their Local Authority. This legislation comes into effect on 30th April 2006. From that date all private landlords must be registered or have submitted an application to register.

Aberdeen City Council together with Aberdeenshire Council have organised two events for Monday, 13th March. One to be held in the afternoon from 2pm to 4pm and one to be held in the

evening from 6.30pm to 8.30pm. The content of each seminar will be the same.

The practical implementation of the registration of private landlords and the implications for private landlords and agents will be the main focus of discussion at the meeting.

Representatives from the Scottish Executive, the Scottish Association of Landlords (SAL), the Scottish Rural Property Business Association

(SRPBA) will be at both events.
