1. You are always advised in advance of any changes to the payable amounts or payment dates. This will give you plenty of time to query any payment.
2. You are guaranteed an immediate refund in the unlikely event of an error being made by us or your Bank/ Building Society.
3. You can cancel at any time by simply advising your Bank or Building Society in writing.
4. This guarantee is offered by all Banks and Building Societies that take part in the Direct Debit scheme.
5. The efficiency and security of the scheme is monitored and protected by your own Bank or Building Society.
