## Fun5z Netball

Fun5z is the game recommended by Netball Scotland for players aged 5 and upwards. Fun5z is played between 2 teams of 5 players on a smaller court using a smaller ball, a lower post and a variety of modified rules which are summarised below. The Scottish Netball Association recommends that the Fun5z philosophy is applied at all festivals for Primary School netball.

### Modified Rules

1. Size 4 ball
2. Goal post adjusted to 8ft (2.4m)
3. Players must rotate positions
4. Minimum shuffling on landing
5. Up to 4 seconds to release the ball
6. Defence must be 0.9 m (3ft) away with hands down, i.e no marking of pass or shot, however 1 jump is allowed to intercept pass or shot when ball is released.
7. 1-2-1 marking at all times

Please make particular note of rule 3 above and ensure that at all festivals all players regularly rotate positions and play in all positions, as a general guide and as far as possible we would advise rotating as follows:

GK to GD to C to GA to GS to GK  
 or  
 GS to GA to C to GD to GK to GS

Entries can be taken at any time throughout the year using the application form attached. However they MUST be received no later than a week before each event to allow organisation for each festival day.

## Confirmation

A confirmation letter/email will be sent a week prior to the festival. If you do not receive this confirmation please contact your ASC to ensure you are included in the playlist for the festival. An order of play for each event will be handed out at each event. Coaches may be required to umpire.

## What to Bring

Participants should arrive wearing training shoes, t-shirt and shorts and bring water to drink. A set of netball playing bibs should also be provided by each school.

## Festival Ethos

As the ethos for participation festivals is fun there will be no winners and scores will not be recorded with the exception of the Inverurie scored festival. The main emphasis will be on fair play and sportsmanship and children should be encouraged to adopt this approach at all festivals.

## Change of Rules/ Regulations

To enable all coaches to be updated on the changes to rules and regulation, as set by netball Scotland, a conversion/ skills workshop has been organised to take place on the 5th October, 4-6pm at Kintore Primary. It would be recommended that all coaches entering teams to a festival attend this workshop. Please confirm your attendance direct with your local Active Schools Coordinator.
