

NORTH EAST PRIMARY SCHOOLS BADMINTON QUAICH COMPETITION

We are now requesting entries for the NE Quaich badminton competition that will be played on Sunday 22 January 2012 at Portlethen Academy, AB12 4QL.

This is a team event requiring 4/5 girls & 4/5 boys per team as each person can only play once in each match. All the team must attend the same school.

The winning team will represent N/E schools at National finals. The winning school must cover any costs involved to go to the finals on 25 February 2012 at Ravenscraig Sports Centre.

Please complete the attached slip to enter team/s. Schools who have intimated they would like to enter a lesser able B team for the experience will be notified if we have the capacity once initial entry intimations have been received.

Information about Quaich Badminton Competition

What is it?

These are competitions for school teams of 4/5 boys and 4/5 girls. Areas throughout Scotland run competitions to find their local champions who then go forward to the national finals to find the "top school" in Scotland.

What constitutes a team?

A minimum of 8 and a maximum of 10 players (per team) with an even gender split of 4/5 boys and 4/5 girls. If schools wish to enter more than one team please intimate this in the email by the 21 Dec.

What is the format? (N.B. Team members can only play once in each match)

Boys Singles, Girls Singles, Boys Doubles, Girls Doubles, Mixed doubles

Entry Fee

The entry fee will be £20.00 per team to be collected by team managers and paid on the day. Cheques made payable to Aberdeenshire Council.

Affiliation

Schools must be affiliated to Scottish Schools Badminton Union before end of December 2011 to enter. There is an affiliation form attached at end of this document. If you are unsure about whether your school has affiliated please contact Joan Prieur.

Closing Date

In the first instance please send intimation by email of your intention to enter a school team by the **21 December 2011** to joan.prieur@aberdeenshire.gov.uk

Then send name of school and team manager's name and contact details to Joan Prieur using the entry slip by **Tuesday 18 January 2011** at the latest.

Arrival at competition

On arrival at the school teams to wait in the reception area at 8.55am where they will be met by one of the Badminton Organisers to be escorted through the school to the Hall.

Times

The competition check in time is at 9.am. The finish time will be dependent on number of teams entered and can be estimated more accurately after the closing date.

Refreshments

Although there is a vending machine at the school for the public use it is not always fully stocked therefore we advise everyone to bring their own refreshments to last the day.

Equipment

Players are requested to bring their own rackets. Anyone who requires to borrow junior rackets on the day should contact Joan. Plastic shuttles will be supplied for the event.
