

West of Scotland chase more success in Inter-Group Badminton Championship

THE LAST domestic Scottish badminton event before Christmas takes place this Saturday, 20 December when the U15/18 Restricted Inter-Group junior competition is staged at Glasgow's Cockburn Centre.

The tournament will feature boys' and girls' singles and doubles as well as mixed doubles and, according to organiser Douglas Walker, it is the best entry he can remember.

In the Under 15 age group defending champions Lothian will be up against 2005 & 2006 winners West of Scotland as well as Borders, Glasgow and North Strathclyde, Highland, Lanarkshire, and our own North East teams.

At Under 18 level West of Scotland will defend their title as they bid to continue their dominance of the event in recent years against Glasgow and North Strathclyde, Lanarkshire, Lothian, and North East.

The competition is only open to those juniors who are not part of the Junior High Performance Squad and is played on a round robin basis with every team being given the opportunity to compete against one another.

Play will start at 10 am on Saturday and spectators can attend free of charge. So why not go and watch some great badminton whilst supporting our North East Team?
