STATEMENT OF REASONS

C24K NEWTONHILL ROAD – PROPOSED ZEBRA CROSSING

Aberdeenshire Council is satisfied that the proposed zebra crossing is required for the following reasons:

- 1) To improve and enhance connectivity and pedestrian safety on the Route to/ from Newtonhill Primary School with the Housing Development at East Monduff via a new surfaced and lit path connection with “Cairnhill Road” providing a safer controlled crossing point for pedestrians on the (C24K) “Newtonhill Road”.
- 2) To enhance safety for pedestrians wishing to access existing playground and recreational facilities and will further enhance safer Routes to School pedestrian links with “Cliff View” and “Crollshillock Place”.

Aberdeenshire Council proposes to introduce a zebra crossing at the undernoted location on the C24K at Newtonhill under Chapter 27, Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984.

At a point 17 metres east of the centre-line of its junction with the U132K St Crispins Road.
