

ABERDEENSHIRE COUNCIL
A944 – ABERDEEN ROAD, ALFORD – PROPOSED 30 MPH SPEED LIMIT

Aberdeenshire Council proposes to make “The Aberdeenshire Council (A944 - Aberdeen Road, Alford) (30 mph Speed Limit) Order, 2010” under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984.

The effect of the order will be to introduce a 30 mph speed limit in Alford as follows.

A944 – ABERDEEN ROAD, ALFORD

From a point 200 metres east of its junction with Castle Road, eastwards for 385 metres
