



Welcome to Inverurie DAYS (Day Activities with Support) Supporting adults with learning disabilities to achieve positive outcomes




We offer a range of services, activities and projects to adults with learning disabilities to meet your individual outcomes.

The Pitscurry Project

The Pitscurry Project provides craft and work activities for adults with learning disabilities. The gardens produce soft fruit and vegetables which supply our on-site café. Activities include, gardening, horticulture, wood kindling, wood work, arts, crafts and pottery. The Pitscurry Project can take up to 25 people per day.





The Buzzard Café

Situated at the top of the Pitscurry site, this training café provides people the opportunity to work both in the kitchen and serving meals to members of the public. This project can take up to 6 people supported by 2 staff members.



The Community Kitchen

Based at the Community Kitchen in the Wyness Hall. People are involved in the preparation and serving of meals. This group can take up to 6 people and is supported by 2 staff members.







Community and Group Opportunities

for people building on personal learning and development. for people who require support to participate in community activities.

active - involved - relationships

We support people to access and participate in activities that support involvement and building networks and relationships. We also recognise the importance of giving people opportunities that provide new learning experiences.

Garioch Community Centre

A group of people access the Garioch Community Centre on Mondays and Wednesdays where they participate in a variety of physical activities including music and movement, drama, football and basketball.





City Moves

A small group of people attend the City Moves dance project in Aberdeen on a weekly basis. They travel there by public transport and enjoy lunch together in town.



The Garioch Gallery

A number of different groups run from within the Garioch Gallery at the Wyness Hall in Inverurie. People work on crafts, poetry and educational activities. The room is equipped with computers and therefore some groups have a technology focus. This project can take up to 6 people and is supported by 2 staff members.



The Westhill Project

A group of people living in the Westhill area meet at Ashdale Hall on Tuesdays and Westhill Community Church on Wednesdays. This group can take up to 7 people and is supported by 2 staff members.
