## Contest Name

Ward 18 - Stonehaven and Lower Deeside

I will now declare the result of the election in the Ward 18 - Stonehaven and Lower Deeside. There are 4 Councillors to be elected.

The electorate was 11,356 and the number of ballot papers received was 5,645 giving a percentage turnout of $49.7 \%$. There were 86 rejected ballot papers. The quota of votes for a candidate to be elected was 1,112 .
