

Funded Work Placement Opportunities

For parents unemployed for 12 months or more

Aberdeenshire Council through No One Left Behind Funding will support provision of paid work placements for parents over 12 months unemployed who have additional barriers to employment.

Placements should offer between 16 – 30 hours per week, fixed term for 6 months but can be flexible to meet the needs of the individual, i.e. term time, less hours for longer. The placements must be supernumerary.
