Gardenstown is a picturesque village with a rich fishing heritage on the northern coast of Aberdeenshire, looking out over the scenic Moray Firth.

A local shop, pub, and tea-room are in the village. Further shops, eateries, and health care services are just 7 miles away in Macduff and 8 miles away in Banff. Gardenstown has a primary school with nursery provision and Banff Academy provides secondary education.

The striking cliffs and abundance of coastal paths offer plenty of scenic walks and trails for the avid walker, with potential for wildlife watching and dolphin spotting. There is a quaint harbour full of creel boats, a thriving arts culture with galleries, pottery, arts, and crafts to enjoy, and historical landmarks such as Fort Fiddes.
