- Applications to amend or cancel existing proxy arrangements must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the address below by 5pm on Wednesday 23 October 2024.
- 5. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of a medical emergency that will prevent a voter from going to the polling station or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the address below by 5pm on Thursday 7 November 2024. The medical emergency must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 30 October 2024 or if the medical emergency occurred before 5pm on Wednesday 30 October 2024, the person could not reasonably be expected to apply by 5pm on Wednesday 30 October 2024. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday 30 October 2024.
