INVERURIE - PROPOSED ZEBRA CROSSING

Aberdeenshire Council is satisfied that the implementation of the proposed Zebra crossing will provide a safer means of crossing Blackhall Road, Inverurie. The crossing has been assessed in line with the Pedestrian Crossing Assessment Policy where it met the criteria for the introduction of a zebra crossing.

INVERURIE - PROPOSED ZEBRA CROSSING

Aberdeenshire Council proposes to introduce a zebra crossing in Inverurie under Chapter 27, Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984.

Zebra Crossing Location - B9170, Blackhall Road, Inverurie, from a point 10 metres or thereby east of the extended east kerb line of Middle Park to a point 10 metres or thereby west of the extended west kerb line of Nether Davah Way.
