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# 1. Overview

This document has been generated from information entered into the Integrated Impact Assessment system.

Allocated budget for private let deficit funding which was previously used in order to cover void rent loss for accommodation which was leased from Registered Social Landlord's for the provision of temporary accommodation. Properties leased from RSLs have now been ended and stock of temporary accommodation is via our own housing stock. The budget saving proposed is £30,000 which will leave a contingency should we require to lease properties which we cannot supply within our own stock in cases of requirements for particular needs.

During screening 1 of 12 questions indicated that detailed assessments were required, the screening questions and their answers are listed in the next section. This led to 1 out of 5 detailed impact assessments being completed. The assessments required are:
