<b>DOUGLAS GORDON ROSS (Scottish Conservative and Unionist)</b>	12,513

Therefore, I give public notice that **SEAMUS LOGAN** is duly elected as the Member of Parliament for the Aberdeenshire North and Moray East constituency.

The total number of votes cast across Aberdeenshire North and Moray East constituency at the UK Parliamentary election on 4 July 2024 was 38,358.

The total number of ballot papers rejected was 170.

The ballot papers were rejected for the following reasons:

<b>20</b>	<b>ballot papers were rejected because votes were given for more than one candidate</b>
<b>0</b>	<b>ballot papers were rejected because there was something written or marked on the ballot paper by which the voter could be identified</b>
<b>150</b>	<b>ballot papers were rejected because they were unmarked or void for uncertainty</b>
