



ELLON – PROPOSED WAITING RESTRICTION

Aberdeenshire Council proposes to make “The Aberdeenshire Council (Station Road, Ellon) (Traffic Management) Order 2025” under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984.

The effect of the order will be to introduce a waiting restriction in Ellon as follows:

PROHIBITION OF WAITING RESTRICTION

Station Road outside number 113 on the east side from its junction with Modley Avenue for a distance of 30 metres or thereby.

ABERDEENSHIRE COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984

THE ABERDEENSHIRE COUNCIL (STATION ROAD, ELLON) (TRAFFIC
MANAGEMENT) ORDER 2025

Aberdeenshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following order:-

1. This order may be cited as “The Aberdeenshire Council (Station Road, Ellon) (Traffic Management) Order 2025”, and shall come into operation on
2. Save as provided in Articles 3 and 4 of this order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this order at any time on any day.
3. Nothing in Article 2 of this order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to wait on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this order for so long as may be necessary: -
 - (a) to enable any person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (b) to enable the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes on any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition; the removal of any obstruction to traffic; the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the said lengths of road or parts thereof; or the laying, erection, alteration or repair of any sewer or of any main, pipe, or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity, or of any kind of communications apparatus as defined in sub-paragraph 1(1) of Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984; or
 - (c) to enable a vehicle owned by a funeral undertaker or owner of funeral vehicles, to be used for a purpose connected with a funeral, but only on occasions when it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose on any other road.
4. Nothing in Article 2 of this order shall apply to any disabled person’s vehicle which is not causing an obstruction and which displays in a relevant position a disabled person’s badge issued by a local authority in exercise of its powers under Section 21(1) of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970.

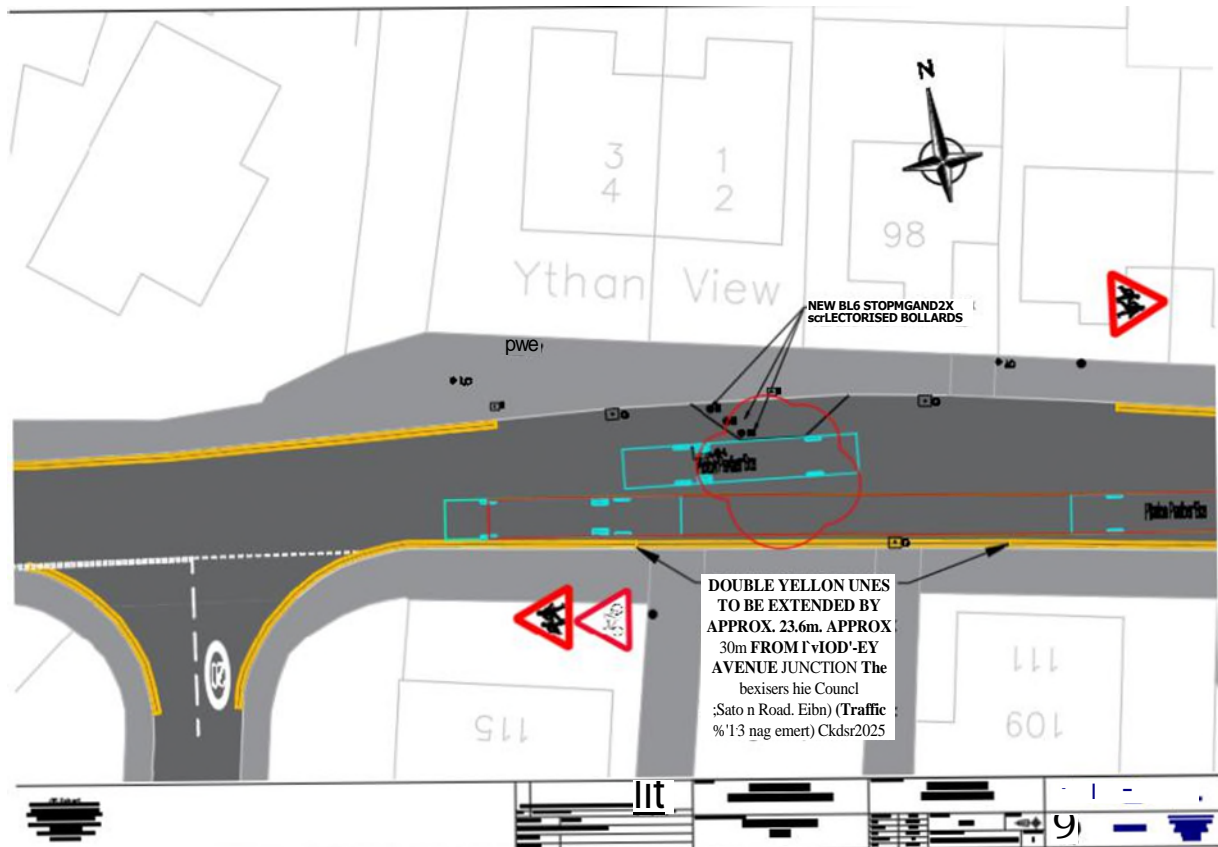
