

BANCHORY - PROPOSED ZEBRA CROSSING

Aberdeenshire Council proposes to introduce a zebra crossing in Banchory under Chapter 27, Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984.

Zebra Crossing Location - Arbeadie Road, Banchory from a point 6 metres north of the extended east kerb line of Ramsay Road to a point 52 metres north of the extended east kerbline of Ramsay Road.

BANCHORY - PROPOSED ZEBRA CROSSING

Aberdeenshire Council is satisfied that the implementation of the proposed Zebra crossing will provide a safer means of crossing Arbeadie Road, Banchory. The crossing has been assessed in line with the Pedestrian Crossing Assessment Policy where it met the criteria for the introduction of a zebra crossing.
